

## Most used Linux commands:

pwd	shows current directory
cd	change to home directory
cd directory1	change directory to directory1
mkdir directory1	create directory with the name directory1 in current directory
more file	outputs the contents of the file
head file	outputs first 10 lines of file
tail file	outputs last 10 lines of file
touch file	touch file
rm file	delete file
rm -r dir	deleting the directory
cp file1 file2	copy file1 to file2
cp -r directory1 directory2	copy directory1 to directory2
mv file1 file2	rename file1 to file2
grep string file	search «string» in the file
grep -r string directory	search «string» in the directory
locate file	find file
ctrl+c	stops current command
trl+d or exit	logout current session
ctrl+w	erases a word in current line
ctrl+u	erases the line
!!	repeat the last command
